What are we working on?



The "Conceptual Framework for embedding sustainability skills in tourism VET curricula" (IO1) has been finalised and it is available in English, Bulgarian, French, Greek, Italian, and Polish languages. It can be freely accessed here.

The developed output has been created on the basis of the desk research results and recommendations from Focus Groups conducted in each country, to provide methodological guidance and supervision in identifying, describing and validating the set of sustainability-related skills required by the tourism sector and possibilities of integrating them in tourism education and training.
